I want to once again Thank-you for giving me the opportunity to have served as your President this past year.



Trey was born January 28, 1988, in Huntington, WV. He will always be remembered for his special connection to horses, his love of riding and training. American Saddlebreds were his favorite horses. He began showing in Futurities at 11 years of age and had a knack for training and presenting young horses in hand and under saddle. From 2000 to 2014, he won over 30 Championships or Reserves in Futurity classes, with horses he raised and trained. Trey was also a gifted musician, guitarist, and song-writer. Those who followed his facebook rants knew him to be a very conservative political thinker.

A member of Zoar Baptist Church, Trey was a believer who liked to share the Word of God with others. On his wandering path, Trey touched many lives. Many have known his kindness and generosity.

Trey is survived by his parents, Joan M. Prasse and Robert H. Prasse, II, his sister and brother-in-law, Shauna and Joshua Riggs, and brother Christopher Prasse, all of Locust Grove; grandparents Jeanette D. Prasse of Fredericksburg, Robert H. Prasse of Waynesboro, VA, and Philip and Jean Modlin of Locust Grove. Also survived by numerous beloved aunts, uncles, and cousins.

Trey's smile, humor, and many talents will be missed. "A light that should have shown brightly has flickered and gone out much too soon."


CLIP THE PROOF-OF-PURCHASE SEALS FOR ASHAV

Southern States' Special Horse Organization Winners (SHOW) Program helps turn empty feed bags into cash for horse-related organizations. Nonprofit breed associations and horse clubs are eligible. Currently more than 300 groups are earning money through the SHOW Program.

Here's how it works:

Register your organization with **Southern States** in Richmond, VA, then get everyone to clip and save the proof-of-purchase seals found on the back of each bag of feed purchased at a Southern States store. For bulk feed purchases, submit the customer copy of the delivery ticket. For every bag of Legends or Triple Crown feed, your organization will receive 25 cents, and \$10 per ton on delivered bulk feed. Reliance feeds are also included at a smaller rebate amount.
